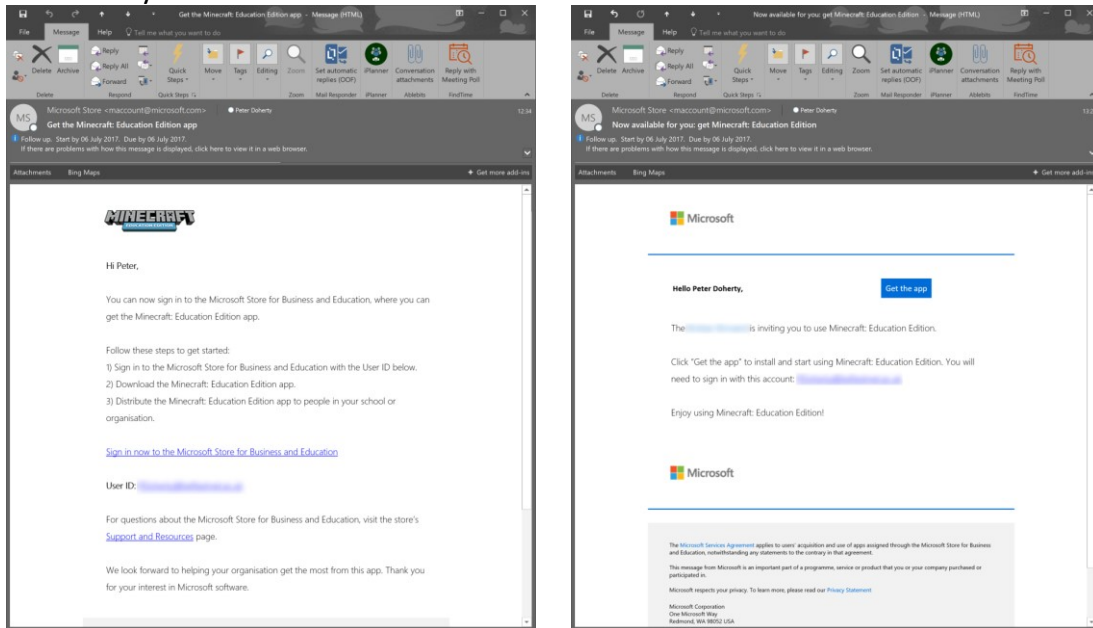




## Installing Minecraft: Education Edition to your Windows 10 device

### Overview

Once you have been assigned a licence for Minecraft: Education Edition by your Administrator you will receive 2 emails similar to the below:



This email provides you with a link to download and install the Minecraft: Education Edition from the Windows Store.

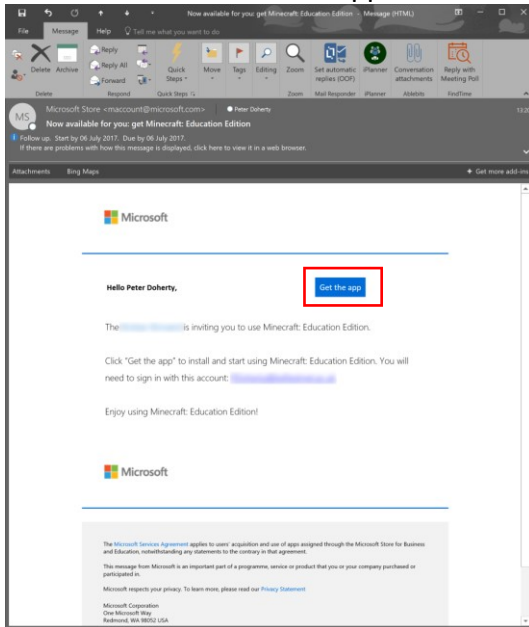
This guide will assist you in downloading and installing the app to your device.

### Step 1

Open the email received with the subject “Now available for you: get Minecraft: Education Edition”

### Step 2

Click on the link “Get the app”

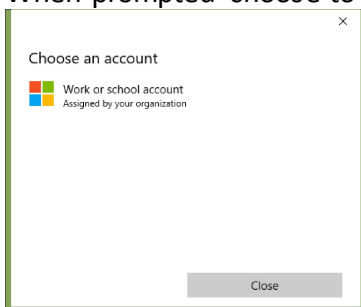


### Step 3

A web browser may open a prompt if you wish to open the link using the Windows Store. If prompted choose yes. Alternatively, the Windows Store may automatically appear.

### Step 4

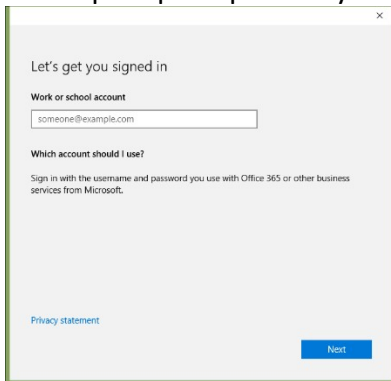
When prompted choose to log in with a Work or school account



## Step 5

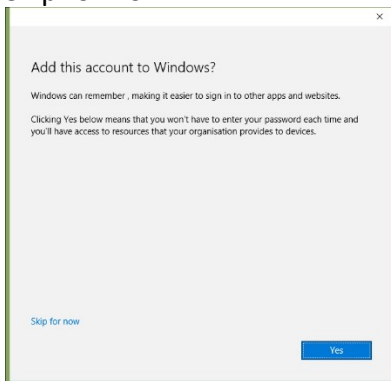
Enter your User ID from the above email (this will be your Office 365 email address) and click Next.

When prompted provide your password.



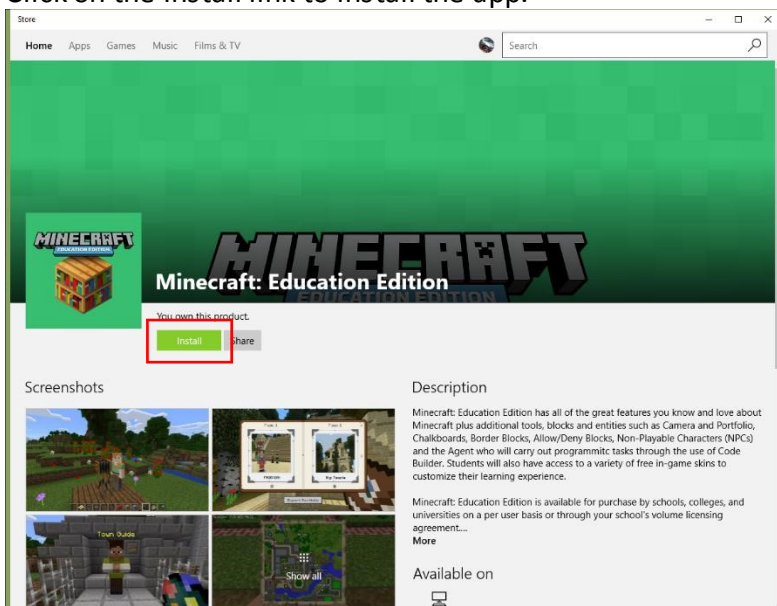
## Step 6

You may be prompted if you want to Add this account to Windows – choose either Yes or Skip for now



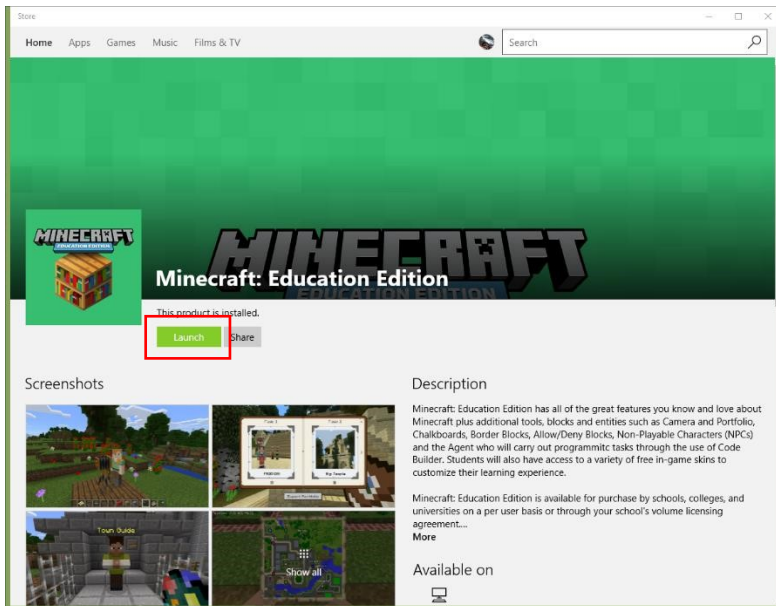
## Step 7

The Windows Store will open on the Minecraft: Education Edition app page. Click on the Install link to install the app.



## Step 8

After a short period the app will be installed and you can click on the Launch button to open Minecraft: Education Edition



Note: you only need to install the app once. To open in the future you can either open the Windows Store, search for Minecraft: Education Edition and click on the Launch button again or simply click on the Start Button and type Minecraft and click on the Minecraft: Education Edition link
